Alberta High School Diploma Requirements (100 Credits)

- English Language Arts 30-1 or 30-2
- Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
- Mathematics 20-1 or 20-2 or 20-3
- Science 20 or Science 24 or Biology 20 or Chemistry 20 or Physics 20
- Physical Education 10
- Career and Life Management (CALM)
- 10 credits from Career & Technology Studies (CTS), fine arts, second languages, Phys Ed 20/30, Knowledge & Employability (K&E) courses
- 10 credits in any 30-level courses including CTS, work experience, K&E, Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP), Green Certificate Specialization, Special Projects 30

Alberta Certificate of High School Achievement Requirements (80 Credits)

- English Language Arts 20-2 or 30-4
- Social Studies 10-2 or 20-4
- Mathematics 10-3 or 20-4
- Science 14 or 20-4
- Physical Education 10
- Career and Life Management (CALM)
- 5 credits in 30-level Knowledge & Employability (K&E), 3000 series Career & Technology Studies (CTS), or 30-level course with occupational focus
- 5 credits in 30-level K&E Workplace Practicum, work experience, Green Certificate course, Special Projects 30
- OR 5 credits in 30-level Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP)
